2. An essay of 500 words or less answering the question: "Why do you want to earn your physics certification?"
3. A letter of recommendation from your principal or supervisor explaining why you would be a good candidate for the program and committing to schedule you to teach at least one section of Algebra-Based Physics in your school district for the 2016-17 school year.
