To learn about PSI-PMI at Share Fair Orlando, register for Demystifying Science and Mathematics for all Students, where you will meet CTL Executive Director Robert Goodman and Senior Program Manager Melissa Axelsson.



Educators who attend, learn about PSI or PMI, and decide to implement either program, will be eligible to apply for grants from CTL for up to 50% of the cost of classroom technology (interactive projectors and responders) and teacher training tuition needed.
